## Guidelines for Student Research Relative to Hippotherapy

The American Hippotherapy Association, Inc. (AHA, Inc.) recommends students complete the following steps prior to engaging in research projects investigating hippotherapy as a treatment strategy.

- Review the AHA, Inc. website
  - Look over the general information explaining hippotherapy, and have an understanding of treatment principles relative to their specific discipline: <u>www.americanhippotherapyassociation.org</u>
- Learn the correct terminology

- Complete a literature review

- Find a mentor

  - Take the opportunity to observe a therapy session and dialogue with a mentor on proposed research topics
